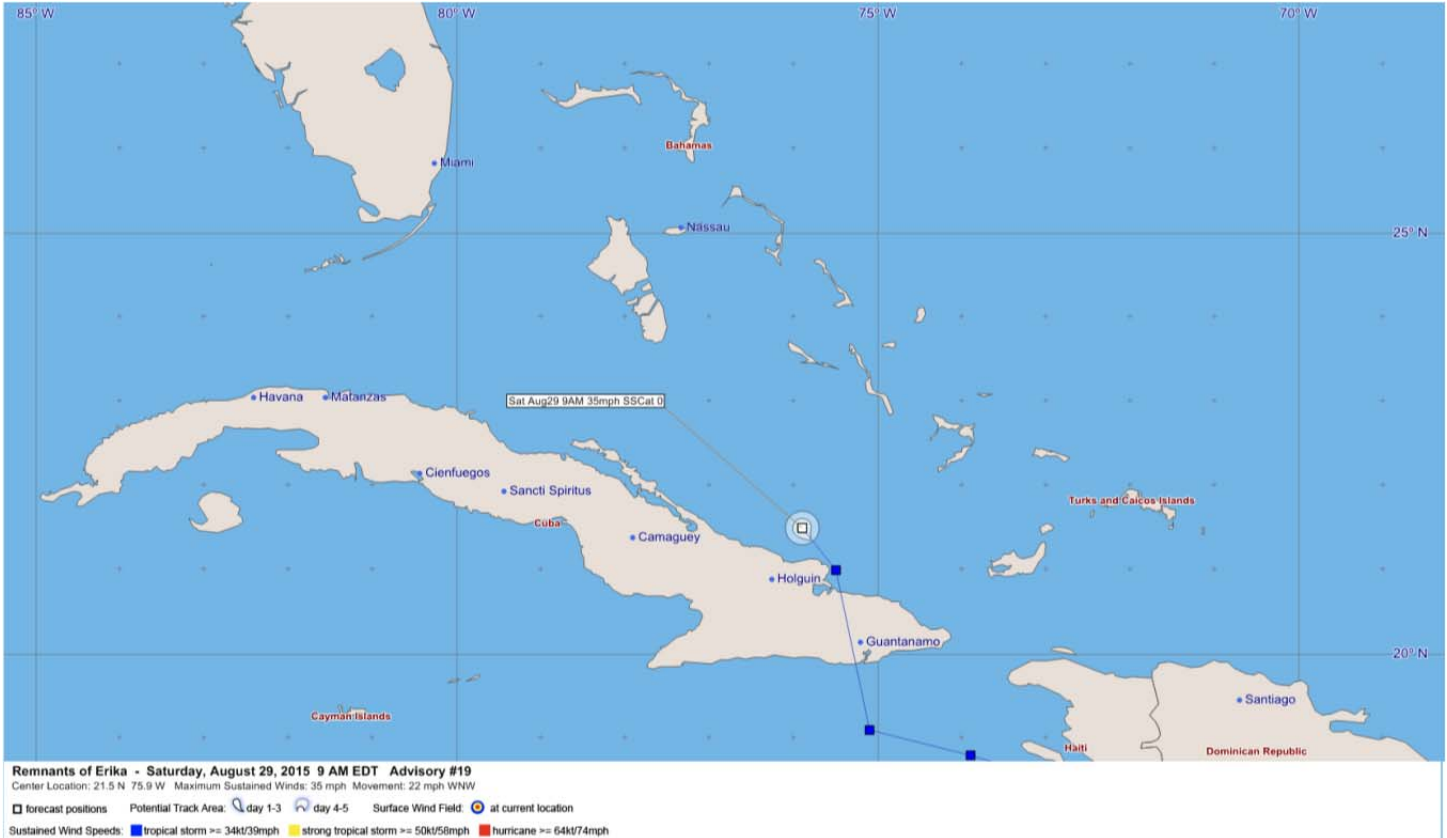

FORECAST

Erika has now **dissipated** to a tropical wave as of the 9:00 AM update. National Hurricane Center and Nation Weather Service is monitoring the remnants for Erika closely and will issue the next update tomorrow at 11:15 AM

Erika is currently a remnants of, with maximum sustained winds of 35 mph (30 kts), moving west-northwest at 22 mph. The estimated minimum central pressure is 1011 mb.

PROTECTIVE ACTIONS

Emergency Management continues to monitor this storm and has been in contact with the National Weather Service and State DEM with multiple conference calls and webinars. It is important that you take this storm seriously and review the emergency plans for your home and office, to make sure that you are prepared in the event that this storm makes its way across the Florida peninsula.

Highlands County EOC will remain at a LEVEL 3 status (monitoring) until further notice.
