

Highlands County Health Facilities Authority Advertisement for Vacancy

The Highlands County Board of County Commissioners is currently seeking applications to fill a vacancy of an unexpired term on the **Highlands County Health Facilities Authority Board**, and will consider interested applicants who have interest, experience or knowledge in public health, including financing health facilities. Applications will be accepted through June 30, 2017.

The Highlands County Health Facilities Authority was established pursuant to the Health Facilities Authorities Law, Ch. 154.209 Florida Statutes, to assist not-for-profit health facilities in the acquisition, construction, financing, and refinancing of projects in any incorporate or unincorporated area within the geographical limits of the local agency. It provides a forum for citizen participation in health care planning and dialogue to address community concerns and problems regarding health care, development and maintenance of the public health in Highlands County, Florida. The Health Facilities Authority is a 5 member board that meets on an as-needed basis to consider matters within its purview. Members serve a 4-year term.
