

The Construction Licensing, Enforcement and Appeals Board is seeking candidates for two regular member positions. The openings will be for an alternate member (public) and contractor.

“The members of the CLEAB shall consist of seven members and two alternates, appointed by the BCC for a period not to exceed four years and may be reappointed for successive terms. The terms of office of the CLEAB members shall be staggered so not more than one-third of the CLEAB is appointed in any 12- month period.

The membership of the Board shall consist of:

- (1) Four contractors, one of whom must be a general contractor.
- (2) Two members at large from the public.
- (3) One member from the building industry.
- (4) Two alternate members; one member from the building industry and one member at large from the public.

Please be advised that appointment to this Board is considered by the State of Florida as an “office.” State law requires that officers of this Board file annual Financial Disclosure Statements with the State of Florida Commission on Ethics, as well as filing a Form F Financial Disclosure Statement within 60 days of resignation or the end of the officer’s term of office if not re-appointed.
